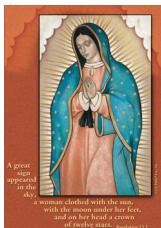
EUCCHARISTIC/LECTOR MINISTERS' ROBES

CHRISTMAS BAGS FOR THE SHUT-INS

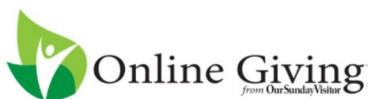
