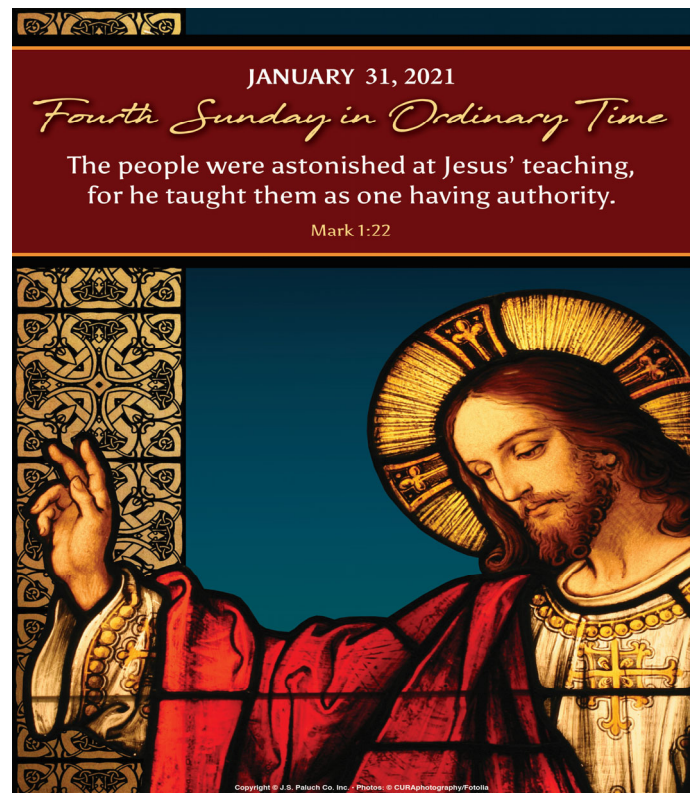

****RELIGIOUS EDUCATION for 2020-21****

Catechism/CCE, RCIC & RCIA (*Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*) has begun for this year, with some changes necessary to meet diocesan requirements and guidelines for safety due to COVID-19. Classes meeting in person are only those in which students are preparing to receive Sacraments (*1st Communion Year 1 and 2, Confirmation Year 1 and 2, RCIC, and RCIA*) for the current time, while all other courses are meeting virtually and/or receiving weekly assignments and activities for family catechesis with teacher support through the GroupMe messaging platform. (Parents/students are added to GroupMe after being registered.)

FEAST OF FAITH

I Confess

One form of the penitential rite at the beginning of Mass is the traditional *Confiteor*, or “I confess,” a prayer that was formerly prayed by the priest alone at the foot of the altar, but which is now prayed by the entire assembly. The *Confiteor* is at once personal—“I confess”—and communal, prayed aloud, together. We recognize that sin does not just separate us from God; sin comes between us and others, isolating us. We acknowledge that sin has many dimensions, individual and communal: sins of thought, sins of speech, sins of action, sins of omission. Sin is not something that happens to us; sin is something we do. In the *Confiteor*, we take responsibility for our own actions. The repeated insistence on our “fault,” with the ritual gesture of striking the breast, an ancient sign of penitence, is not meant to lower our self-esteem. Rather, it acknowledges our human instinct to transfer the blame whenever we can (“The devil made me do it!”). This prayer stops us short. We take responsibility for ourselves, our actions, our failure to act. Then we cry out to God in those ancient words, *Kyrie, eleison*—Lord, have mercy. For the sinner who repents, there is mercy. This truth is at the heart of our faith, and it is where the Mass, our feast of faith, begins. —Corinna Laughlin, Copyright ©
