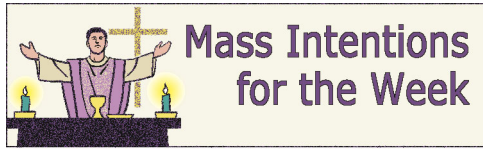

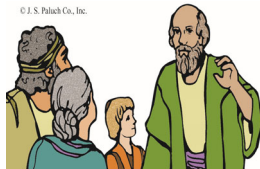

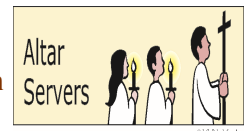


GREAT NEWS

TODAY’S READINGS

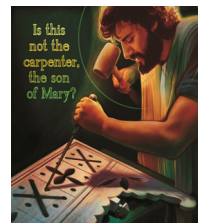
First Reading — They shall know that a prophet has been among them (Ezekiel 2:2-5).
