**AMENDED PARISH DIRECTIVES
OFFICE OF THE BISHOP**

Effective May 20, 2021

1. Public Masses continue at 100% capacity; with responsible distancing.
2. Wearing face masks or coverings is no longer mandatory. Wearing them is left to individual discretion, i.e. priest, deacons, religious and lay faithful.
3. Every pew may now be utilized.
4. Hand sanitizer will be made available at the entrance of the church.
5. Proper sanitizing of pews will be done at least once a week.
6. Distribution of the Precious Blood to the congregation is still suspended.
7. Missalettes and hymnals are now permitted in the pews.
8. Gatherings in parish halls are permissible. Great responsibility must be taken in these gatherings.
9. Classrooms can be utilized. Classrooms must be properly cleaned and sanitized at once a week.

FEAST OF FAITH

The *Corpus Christi* Procession

In the thirteenth century, a Belgian nun by the name of Juliana had a vision: she saw the full moon silvery and radiant except for one dark spot. The meaning of the vision was revealed to her: the moon was the Church's liturgical year, the dark spot a missing feast in honor of the Blessed Sacrament. Today's feast of *Corpus Christi*—the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ—grew from Juliana's vision.



On this feast, many parishes observe the traditional *Corpus Christi* procession, giving honor to the Eucharist by carrying this greatest treasure out of the safety of our churches and into our streets. At the end of every Mass we are not just let out, we are sent forth, strengthened by the Eucharist, to be the Body of Christ in the world. The *Corpus Christi* procession is the dismissal writ large! We take Jesus with us, not only in our hearts, but carried in our midst and exposed in a monstrance. It is a public profession of faith and a blessing of the world. Jesus walks with us on these streets that we walk day after day, among those who know him but yearn to know him better, and among those who do not know him. 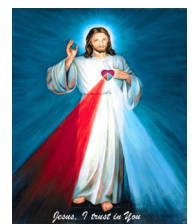


SANCTUARY & ADORATION CANDLE
