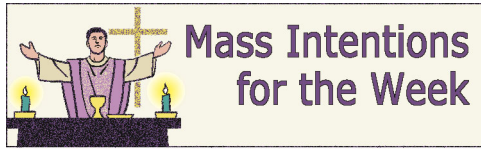

 May is considered the Month of Mary. We encourage everyone to pray the Rosary daily.

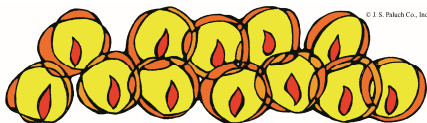
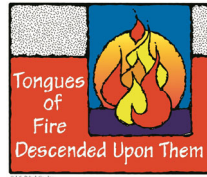
**CLASS OF 2021 SENIOR MASS**
