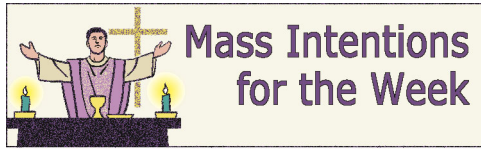

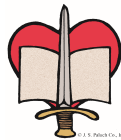

PEW UP DATE FROM THE MARSHALL CO.

As with many manufacturers, we are experiencing some significant delays due to COVID, raw material delays, and also a reduced work force. We've already had several of our key employees out with COVID, and a few others needing to quarantine due to a family member having the illness.

We've also experienced material shortages and shipping delays in the past several months, everything from fabric, glue, lumber, and foam. From speaking with the contractors that we are working with on our projects, many are experiencing these supply delays as well, including tile, carpet, and lighting. Another new issue to us is a shortage of available workers.

Needless to say, we are working tirelessly with what we have in order to keep production flowing, however, shipping delays at this point are inevitable. Barring any other COVID related delays, we have both Ingleside and Odessa tentatively shipping late November.
