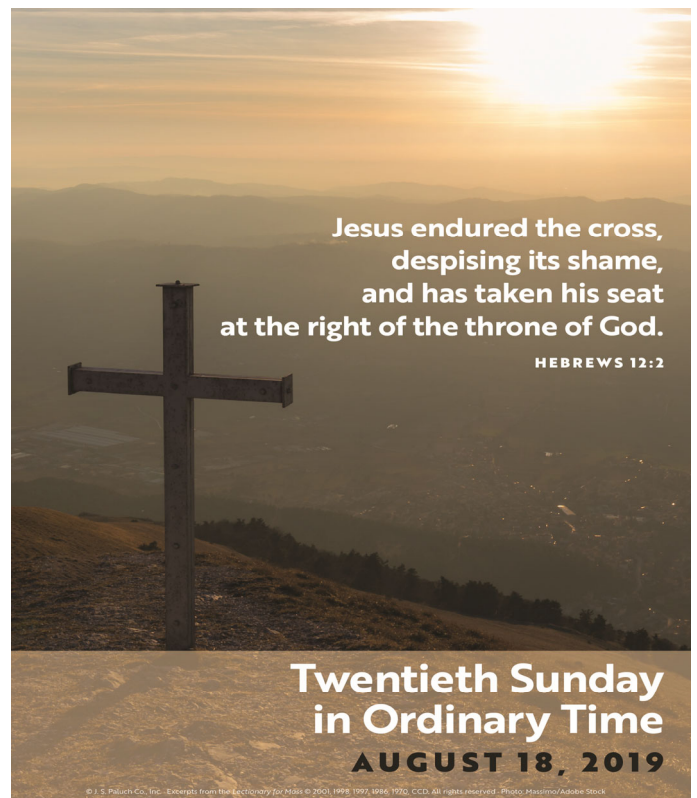

CHILDREN'S LITURGY

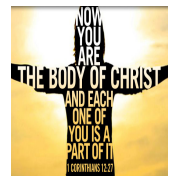
