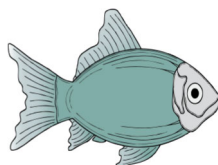

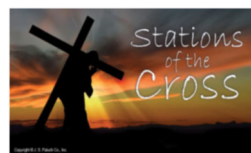
## LENTEN FISH FRY
