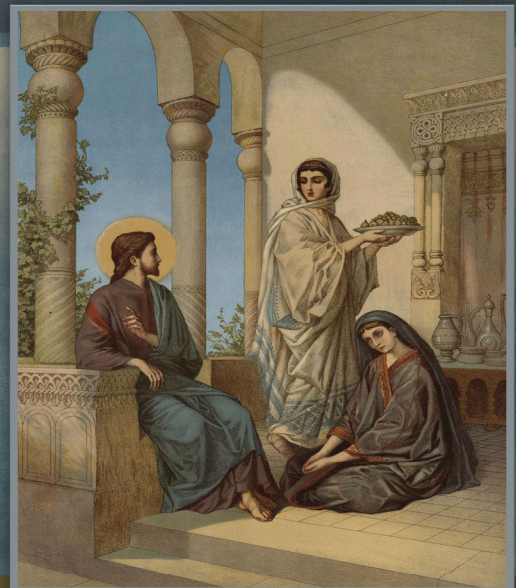

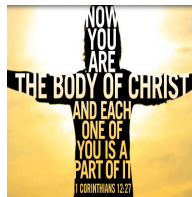

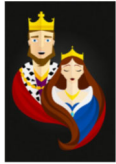

PARISH RENOVATION AND REPAIR WORK UPDATE

It has been brought to Fr. Patrick's attention that the current power supply equipment to the church is in need of urgent replacement. It was built almost 30 years ago. The outside humidity and exposure to the elements over the years has led to the equipment being corroded and rusted. The fear is that at any time power could be lost to the entire church campus. The finance council has approved to completely replace our current power supply equipment with a new underground AEP feeder. The cost to the parish is about \$9000.
