Due to COVID-19, Bishop Mulvey asks to adhere to the following protocol:

Distribution of the Precious Blood is suspended
Holy Water Fonts are to remain empty
The faithful are strongly encouraged to wear a mask or other face covering upon entering the church and during the celebration of Mass
Compliance with social distancing requirements (seating 6ft apart from on another)
This protocol will continue until further notice.

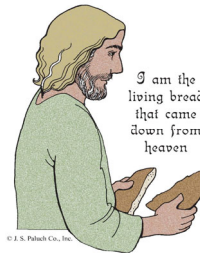

MASS TIMES CHANGES

The Saturday and Sunday evening Masses will be celebrated on hour earlier from the current time of 6pm to the new time of 5pm. Confessions will be from 4-5pm (with some restrictions in keeping with Bishop Mulvey's directives during this health emergency).

Our youth group, Kids for Christ can conclude meeting at 8pm instead of 9pm (when we reopen). These are the only two Mass times that are changing, all other Masses remain unchanged. Fr. Patrick believes that by having the evening Masses earlier families have more time to spend with one another.



FOOD FROM HEAVEN

God sustained the people of Israel for forty years in the desert with manna sent down from heaven, and Moses doesn't want them to forget it. God brought forth water from stone for them to drink, and Moses doesn't want them to forget this, either. And Moses tells them—

twice—that the food that God sent was a food that neither they nor their ancestors before them had ever experienced before.

Jesus too speaks of food come down from heaven, food that the Jewish people had never experienced before. Recalling the manna in the desert, Jesus doesn't want them to forget it either, explaining that he is the food and drink of eternal life.
