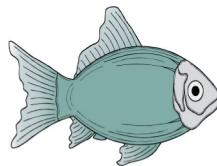

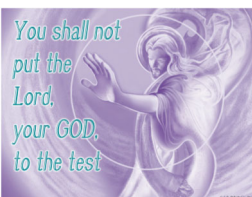
SANCTUARY & ADORATION CANDLE
