This protocol will continue until further notice.

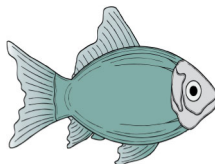
## HEALTH PRECAUTION

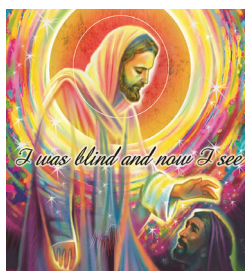
