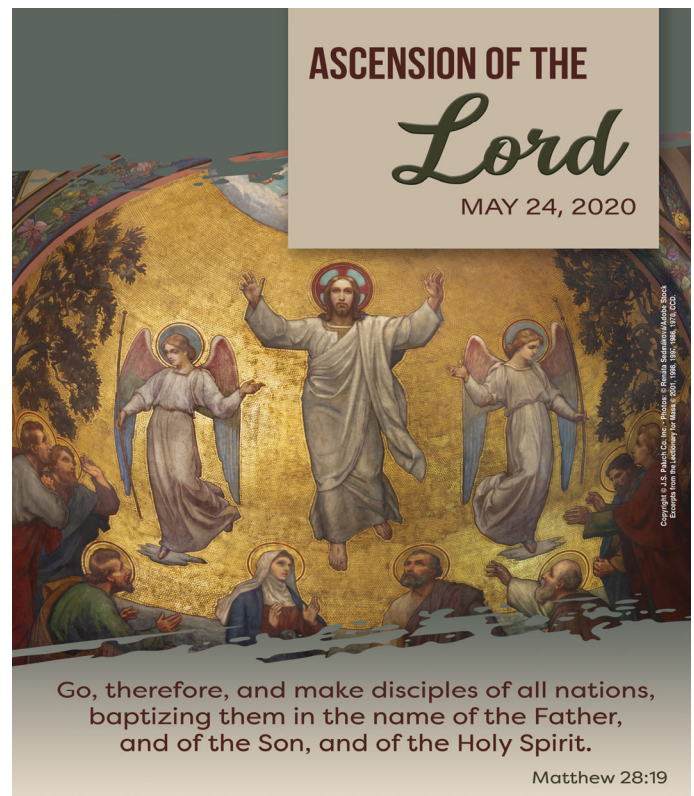

Holy Water Fonts are to remain empty

The faithful are strongly encouraged to wear a mask or other face covering upon entering the church and during the celebration of Mass

Compliance with social distancing requirements (seating 6ft apart from on another)

This protocol will continue until further notice.

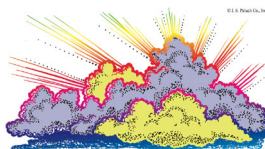

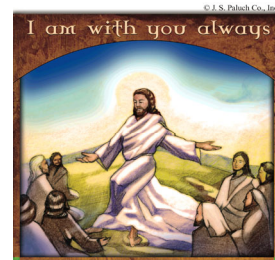
### ONLINE GIVING

### The Ascension of the Lord

The key to unlocking the scriptures is in Paul's letter to the Ephesians as we pray, "May the eyes of your hearts be enlightened." People see and hear things but simply have a hard time believing they are true. In our first reading from

the very beginning of the Acts of the Apostles, Luke starts where his Gospel left off—the ascension of Jesus. For as long as Jesus spent preparing the disciples, they were still foggy about what was happening, and spent time staring at the sky wondering where he went. In today's Gospel, the disciples still doubt Jesus to the very last minute. In the letter to the Ephesians, Paul speaks to the new Christian community, but could be preaching to each of us in the pews as he says, "I can explain it to you, but I can't make you believe.
